



Frequently Asked Questions

At what age can my child attend Mainly Music?

You can start your child from birth. Once your baby becomes more interested - or even is awake - during the sessions, bounce your child, swing and sway your child, move their hands to the movements. And when your baby becomes a toddler, they will be keen to participate.

Can I start mid-term or mid-year?

Yes. Mainly Music is a fun interactive music session – not music classes. So, you're not coming in part-way into a curriculum. You can join at any time.

What if I miss a week?

We understand that sometimes routines go off course, children get sick, mornings just don't happen the way you expected. We'd appreciate a quick text message to let us know you can't come. That way we can invite another family that is waiting patiently for a spot. If you miss two weeks or more, we'll give you a call.

How much does it cost to attend mainly music?

\$10 per family per session or \$60 for the whole term. If you are unsure about how often you can come, talk to us and we can consider a week by week payment

Do I need to take anything to a mainly Music session?

No, everything is provided.

Do I need to put myself on a roster because I am attending the sessions?

No, as a project of Gartrell Church, the Mainly Music sessions are presented by volunteers from the church. However, it is good for children to learn to put things away, so any help packing up the many toys that children and parents enjoy would be gratefully received.

I hear you have a waiting list; how long will it take to get a permanent position?
